

911 KAR 2:200E summary
Coverage and Payment for Kentucky Early Intervention Program Services

- **This proposed amendment:**
- Adds definitions of “CCSHCN” and “Collateral Service”, and changes the definitions for “Period of Eligibility” and “Therapeutic intervention”.
- Clarifies provider participation requirements.
- Provides clarification of how specific services must be provided (e.g. by telephone, at meetings, face-to-face, etc.).
- Reduces some provider rates for assessments and therapeutic interventions by an average of 7% based on the cost/time study completed by Solutions, Inc.
- Adds procedures for requesting additional units of service.
- Clarifies that if a professional and a paraprofessional of the same discipline are providing therapeutic intervention for a child, their combined time with the child cannot exceed one (1) billable hour per week.
- Adds language that Family Share does not apply to a family who chooses to use their private insurance if the amount of insurance coverage is equal to or greater than the sum of the obligated amount of Family Share during the calendar year.
- Adds policy that for children receiving Medicaid, the Commission will bill the families’ private insurance, if any, before billing Medicaid. This is being done in order to comply with Medicaid federal law.
- Adds language that the changes made to this administrative regulation are effective with bills received at CBIS on or after June 15, 2002.
